



2 Day Kalumbaru Aboriginal Experience 4wd Self-drive Extension

This 2-day extension to the existing itinerary option allows a more in depth exploration of the Kimberley Coastal regions. Originally a Catholic Mission, Kalumbaru 'saw action' in WW11 and is now a remote town on the King Edward River. Kalumbaru is rich in natural attractions with delightful beaches offering excellent fishing and the opportunity to go bush with the Traditional Owners. The French Family will be your hosts as you spend a delightful 2 days fishing, relaxing or exploring.

Suggested Itinerary

Day 1 King Edward River to Honeymoon Bay

From the King Edward River at the base of the Mitchell Plateau, you can head north along the Kalumbara Road until arriving at the Carson River. This gives you the opportunity for a refreshing dip before continuing the journey to Honeymoon Bay. After a stop at the NB. The 'extra day' is gained, as you would have been travelling down the Telegraph Track anyway. This trip can also be done in reverse.
