



1 Day Quinkan Art 4WD Self-Drive Extension

For the appreciators of Aboriginal Art, much more time can profitably be spent around Laura visiting the art sites. To fully appreciate the range and quality of this rich treasure of art, it is better if you are able to stay overnight at the Trezise Families Bush Camp at Jowalbinna, on the Little Laura River, and undertake a guided tour to the art sites. This extension is available to any of our itineraries from Cairns but cannot be taken just as a 1-day hire.

Suggested Itinerary

Day 1 Laura to Jowalbinna

Travel from Laura on the Maytown Track and it takes about 1 & 1/2 hours to get to the camp from Laura. The road is quite rough. Arrange for a tour with local guides to get maximum value from your visit.

Overnight camping Jowalbinna Bush Camp. (50km 1&1/2 hours driving)

Day 2 Jowalbinna to Laura

Return to Laura and resume your journey
